## TASTING NOTES

2024 Singlefile Great Southern Fiano

*Great Southern, Western Australia*

### VINEYARD & WINEMAKING

Fiano is a white Italian grape variety that is grown primarily in the Campania region of southern Italy and on the island of Sicily. It has been introduced to the Great Southern region in more recent years and the 2024 growing season delivered ideal conditions for fiano. Spring and summer were dry and warm, encouraging full ripe fruit flavours before an early harvest.

The fiano fruit was picked after dawn on 27 February 2024. The fruit was sorted and then pressed. The juice underwent a long and slow cold fermentation in a stainless-steel tank immediately after pressing to preserve the natural fruit characters. When the wine had completed its fermentation, it was racked off its lees. The purpose of this approach is to maintain the subtle textures and crisp finish. The wine was prepared for bottling in August 2024.

### THE WINE

A lighter styled fiano with lifted aromas of lemon and spice. The citrus aromatics follow through on the palate, enhanced further with a softly textured mouth feel and some subtle nutty flavours on the finish. This wine is well suited to complement light, fresh white meat and seafood dishes. It can be enjoyed now, or allow the wine to continue to develop in the bottle for up to 7 years.
