2024 Singlefile 'The Pamela' Porongurup Riesling

Honan Vineyard Porongurup, Great Southern

VINEYARD & WINEMAKING

The Porongurup subregion of the Great Southern has developed a reputation for producing world class rieslings in recent years. 'The Pamela' is from mature riesling vines at the Honan Vineyard on the north east corner of the Porongurup range. The vineyard is approximately 300m above sea level and protected by a natural rain shadow (from the nearby Porongurup range) and has a northern aspect on lateritic soils. This cool site with minimal rainfall creates a pristine environment for mature riesling vines to thrive.

The 2024 growing season delivered early ripening conditions with good rainfall over winter. Spring was dry, and a relatively warm summer encouraged early fruit ripeness, with picking carefully timed to retain the fruit's beautiful natural acidity.

Winemaking was focussed on preserving the delicate flavours and aromas from the fruit and allowing the vineyard's sense of place to shine through.

THE WINE

Pale quartz in colour this wine shows beautiful aromatics of lemon sherbet with subtle hints of sea-salt and pronounced minerality that will develop further in bottle. The palate is characterised by the natural acidic drive of the wine, with flavours of lemon juice, apple and stony talc flowing through the length of the palate. The long finish hums with citrusy acidity. There is superb drive, length and balance to this wine. Cellar with confidence to develop complex minerality and richness over the next 20 years.
